Thank you for your enrolment inquiry.

Located in the beautiful Camden Valley, Mater Dei, Camden, is a co-educational school for students from Kindergarten to Year 12, who have been assessed with mild to moderate cognitive disability. Students from Kindergarten to Yr 12 may be enrolled as Day Students whilst students from Yr 7 to Yr 12 have the opportunity to participate in Mater Dei's Family Resource and Residential Program on a part-time basis during the school terms.

I take pleasure in forwarding some relevant information on Mater Dei along with an Application Form for Enrolment. If you wish your son/daughter to be considered for enrolment, please forward:

- A completed Application Form
- A Copy of a current (not older than 2 years) Psychometric Assessment
- A copy of the Student's Birth Certificate
- A Copy of the most recent School Report (if applicable)
- A Copy of the current Individual Education Program (if applicable)
- \$50 Enrolment Application Fee (Non Refundable)

For a student to be enrolled at Mater Dei his/her primary disability must be assessed and shown to be within the mild to moderate range of cognitive disability. We assess each individual child and their needs and so we do not operate a traditional first come first served waiting list and we do not hold a waiting list for future years.

If you will be relying on the Special Transport Service to transport your child to Mater Dei, please be aware that the criteria includes your demonstrated inability to transport your child yourself **and** a residential address within a 40km radius of Mater Dei.
